

## Shop Safety

The Reber Undergraduate Student Workshop and Graduate Machine Shop have some of the latest technologies and equipment available for students, faculty and staff to utilize.

We are rigorous in our efforts to ensure that precautions and safeguards are in place to protect users of this equipment from being injured. Both the equipment and facility must be treated with the utmost respect for safety. Safety equipment such as: eye protection, ear protection, gloves, aprons and face shields are available for use.

Safety Glasses and close toed shoes are required upon entry into either shop.

Training on equipment safety and usage is available and required before a student is allowed to operate the machinery in the Undergraduate Student Workshop. Graduate Students wanting to operate equipment in the Machine Shop, must have a certificate of training from the Learning Factory or obtain training from the staff machinist prior to usage.

Students are required to clean up their equipment and surrounding area when finished working in the shops.
